

Catch Up Funding Spending Plan 2018/19

What is catch up premium and how is it used at Ormiston SWB Academy?

Catch up premium is additional funding given to schools to support pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or mathematics at the end of Key Stage 2. It is up to schools to decide how to use the funding most effectively to support students who have not reached the expected standard.

For the academic year 2018/19, Ormiston SWB Academy expects to receive approximately £18,500 Catch Up funding. The funding will be allocated as follows:

Action	Expected Expenditure	Rationale
TA Support for Additional Literacy and Numeracy Catch Up Classes in English and Maths for Year 7 classes that include catch-up students.	£4,100	Improve progress, confidence and fluency in numerical and reading skills
Primary specialist teacher time to plan, deliver and mark lessons for dedicated English and Maths Y7 groups. An additional weekly numeracy and reading lesson for catch up students.	£12,000	Lessons developing independent reading strategies and vocabulary decoding. Lessons dedicated to developing numerical fluency.
Renaissance Reading programme (Accelerated Reader)	£2,400	To close the gap between pupils' chronological age and reading age.
