



2021 Teacher Assessed Grades - Year 11 and Year 13

How will year 11 and year 13 students be assessed?

Year 11 and Year 13 students will be awarded what the Department for Education are calling a 'teacher assessed grade' in light of the impact of COVID 19. The information below summarises the process.

- We will determine grades based on the standard at which a student has performed across the entire course.
- We will collect a range of evidence to arrive at a grade for each student so that each grade is determined objectively.
- Subject leaders and the Senior Leadership Team will decide upon evidence.
- Assessments will be quality assured and moderated both internally and externally.

When will students receive results?

Year 13 results day: Tuesday 10th August. Year 11 results day: Thursday 12th August.

Is there an appeals process?

Yes. Students can appeal the grades on or after they receive their results. If a student wishes to appeal they should:

- Ask the school to submit a formal appeal to the exam board.
- The exam board will then check the processes followed in school, review the evidence and provide a view as to whether or not the grade awarded was reasonable.
- If the exam board finds the grade is not reasonable they will determine the alternative grade and inform the centre.
