




## Advice for Families about Enhanced Testing Requirements

	Which Test?	Household Implications	What next?
	<p><b>Feeling fine and well</b> Making testing part of your routine and take a Lateral Flow Test (LFT) twice a week</p>	<p><b>None – unless LFT is positive</b></p>	<p><b>Positive</b> – Case and household isolate for 10 days and case gets a confirmatory PCR test within 24 hours</p> <p><b>Negative</b> – carry on as normal</p>
	<p><b>*Reporting your child's sickness absence?</b> Social contact must be limited, and the child should stay home apart from going to get a free PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test</p>	<p><b>None – unless PCR test result is positive</b></p>	<p><b>Positive</b> – case and household isolate for 10 days. All household gets a PCR test within 24 hours</p> <p><b>Negative</b> – return to setting when feeling unwell</p>
	<p><b>**Got Covid-19 symptoms?</b> You must self-isolate and get a free PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test</p>	<p><b>YES</b> Household required to isolate for 10 days or until negative PCR test result</p>	<p><b>Positive</b> – case and household isolate for 10 days from first day of symptoms. All household gets a PCR test within 24 hours</p> <p><b>Negative</b> – isolation ends</p>
	<p>*If no test taken, return to setting only after 48 hours of feeling well</p>		
	<p>**If no test taken, case and household complete a full 10 day isolation period.</p>
