



HARMFUL SEXUALISED BEHAVIOUR AND WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ...

- 1. Any form of sexual harassment is not acceptable and will not be tolerated
- 2. Sexual harassment has consequences for all parties
- 3. Sexual violence is a criminal offence and may result in a permanent exclusion and criminal record
- 4. You can talk to any member of staff you will be taken seriously and listened to
- 5. Sexual harassment at the lowest level includes name calling and unwanted comments of a sexual nature
- 6. You can report any concerns anonymously on the school website "reporting anonymously"

HARMFUL SEXUAL BEHAVIOURS



This is normal behaviour for adolescents:

- Private conversations of a sexual nature with close friends, where both parties feel comfortable
- Use of internet/e-media to chat online with friends
- Having non-sexual relationships
- Sexual activity including hugging, kissing, holding hands outside of the Academy
- Oral and/or penetrative sex above the legal age of 16 providing both parties consent and are capable to independently make this decision for their age

SPEAK TO ANY TRUSTED ADULT OR...



• Choosing not to be sexually active



This is not acceptable and needs to be reported;

- Exposing genitals
- Inappropriate sexual language
- Accessing exploitative or violent pornography
- Single occurrence of peeping, exposing, mooning or obscene gestures
- Taking and sending naked or sexually provocative images of self or other
- Giving out contact details online
- Joining adult-only social networking sites and giving false personal information
- Arranging a meeting with an online contact alone
- Sexual degradation/humiliation of self or others
- Attempting/forcing others to expose genitals
- Sexually aggressive/exploitative behaviour
- Sexual harassment
- Non-consensual sexual activity
- Use of/acceptance of power and control in sexual relationships
- Sexual contact with others where there is a big difference in age or ability
- Sexual activity with someone in authority and in a position of trust
- Sexual activity with family members
- Involvement in sexual exploitation and/or trafficking
