#### Instrumental/Vocal lessons 2022-2023

We are writing with details regarding peripatetic instrumental/vocal tuition for 2022-2023. Please ensure that you carefully read the contents of this letter and discuss it with your son or daughter.

The Academy are in the process of securing our required tuition time for next academic year with Wolverhampton Music Service and if you are interested in music tuition in the next academic year, we would appreciate a quick response by returning the completed agreement (attached) to Reception.

Payment must be made via ParentMail within the first week of each term. Failure to do so will result in the service being withdrawn until payment is made.

Students are guaranteed at least 33 lessons which are held weekly for a minimum of 20 minutes, in groups.

They will take place during the normal school day (including breaks and lunchtimes) and are rotated on a weekly basis to ensure the same lesson is not being missed. Students are expected to check when their lesson is scheduled on the morning of their lesson to ensure that there has not been any unavoidable changes. It is their responsibility to liaise with members of school staff to catch up on any work that they may have missed. If you wish to withdraw from lessons, please submit this in writing with one half term's notice.
