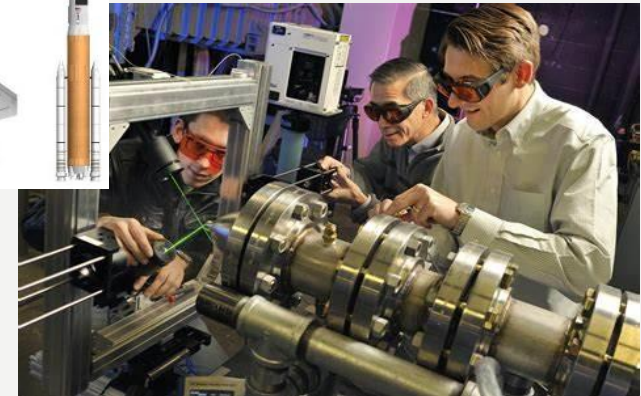
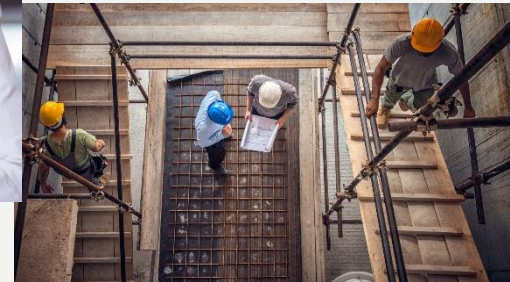

STEM CAREER FACTS

- Engineering jobs makes up 19% of the UK's total employment
- 27% of enterprises in the UK are engineering related
- 1 in 8 Engineers are women
- Engineering in the UK employs 5.6 million people
- 51% of 11-16 year olds said they would consider a career in engineering
- 68% of those gaining a degree in Engineering were full time employed within 6 months
- On average professional Engineers earn more that any other professional
- 65 million engineering jobs are predicted to be available for 2024
