








### **Explore MOOCs**

You can rank and filter MOOCS to narrow down your searches to what is most important to you.






#### How can Unifrog help me now?

#### **Creating your account**


- Most students will already have set up their passwords.

- Make a note of your password.






#### Every time you login to Unifrog from now on, sign in here

- It will also detail any interactions logged against your child, such as Careers Fairs taking place or careers interviews coming up.




