Component 1: Human Lifespan Development

<u>Aim:</u> To be able to understand how we grow and develop throughout our lives

<u>Assessment</u>: internally assessed assignments

Weighting: 30% of total course

During this component you will:

- Explore how individuals develop physically, emotionally, socially and intellectually over time.
- Investigate how various factors, events and choices impact individuals' growth and development.
- Discover how people adapt to life events and cope with change.



Component 2 - Health and Social Care Services and Values

<u>Aim:</u> To be able to get to know how the Health and Social Care sector works and the care values that lie at its core.

Assessment: internally assessed assignments

Weighting: 30% of total course

During this component you will:

- Learn which health and social care services are available
- > Identify why people might need to use these services
- > Discover who's involved in providing these services
- Explore what might stop people from accessing the services they need
- Look at the care values the sector has to make sure people get the care and protection they need.



Component 3- Health and Wellbeing

<u>Aim</u>: To be able to understand the factors and actions which can improve a individual's health and wellbeing

<u>Assessment:</u> externally assessed exam, in which students create a health and wellbeing improvement plan for an individual

Weighting: 40% of total course

During this component you will:

- > Learn what 'being healthy' means to different people
- Explore the different factors that might influence health and wellbeing
- Identify key health indicators and learn how to interpret them
- > Assess an individual's health using what they've learned
- Create a health and wellbeing improvement plan for that person
