## What skills will I learn?

### What topics will I study?

#### Crime and Punishment & White Chapel 1000-present and Whitechapel, c1870-c1900

The origins of crime and the legal system. Learn how criminals were caught, treated and punished from the middle ages to the modern day. Study the social roots of prisons, reform and policing. Case study: Whitechapel murders - how did London police fail to catch Jack the Ripper?

#### Elizabethan England, 1558-1588

Renaissance England, war with Spain, discovery and expansion of a burgeoning empire. Delve into the religious crisis of the Tudor period and why the Queen's life was in danger for much of her reign.

#### The American West 1835-1895

The expansion of the USA into the West and the displacement of native people. Discover the way of life of the Native Americans, how they lost their fight for freedom and the impact of the endless march of progress. The true and sordid story of America's rise to greatness

#### Weimar & Nazi Germany 1919-1939

How did Hitler, a poor artist from Austria, become one of the most evil men in history? How did Germany turn from the most progressive and forward thinking societies on earth, into the darkest place in world history?
