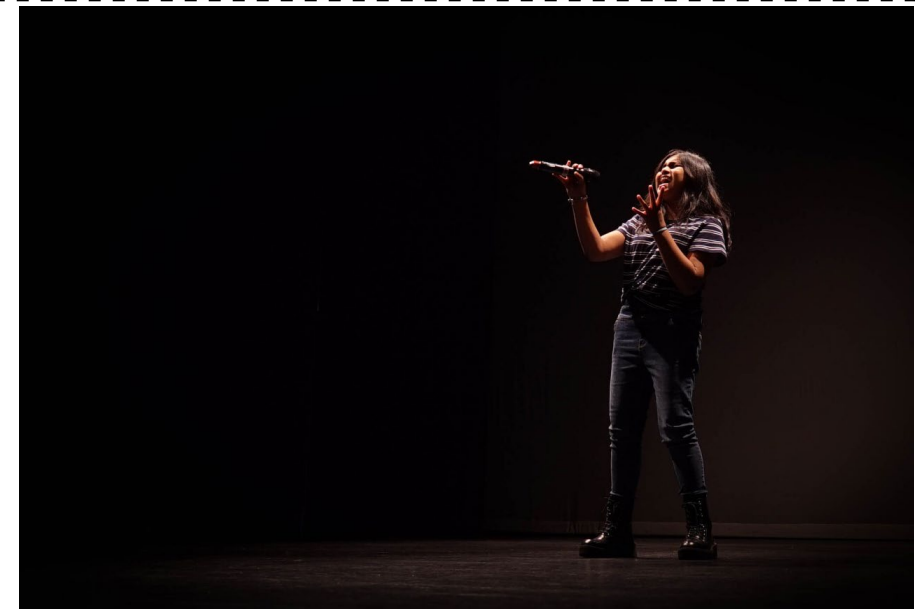
You can start to take lessons in school on an instrument of your choice... (Voice, Guitar, Drums, Piano and more!)
