Have your say about the potential relocation of services to a new Bilston Health & Wellbeing Facility

City of Wolverhampton Council is working with a wide range of stakeholders, including the local community, health care users and providers, to help shape the future services offered from the new Bilston Health & Wellbeing Facility. Some of the potential services to be offered include:

- Bilston Urban Village and Ettingshall Medical Centres - Primary Care Services
- Church Street and Caerleon Surgeries - Primary Care Services
- Rocket Pool Family Hub - Start for Life and Family Help Services
- Black Country Health - Mental Health Services
- Compton Care - Palliative Care Outreach Services

Applications for the re-location of the primary care services have been submitted to the NHS Black Country Integrated Care Board. Stakeholders including the community and patients are being invited to have their say about how they could be impacted by any potential service relocations.
