In light of recent changes to legislation on school uniform, please see our uniform list below. There are 4 essential uniform items that need to have a logo (including the year group specific tie)

Uniform list

Blue Blazer with academy logo (essential)
Light blue school shirt/blouse
Academy year clip on tie (essential)
Formal black trousers – No jeans/cords/leggings or flares.
Plain black knee length, half pleated skirt with academy logo (essential). Alternatively, Formal black trousers – No jeans/cords/leggings or flares.
Summer term only – Navy blue polo t-shirt with academy logo (optional). Alternatively, a plain navy blue polo t shirt can be worn (with no logo's)
Black socks or tights
Plain black sensible formal school shoes – no trainers, plimsolls, heeled, open toe/backed shoes, including Nike Air Force, Nike Air Max, Converse All Star or equivalent
School bag (large enough to fit A4 books/folders)

PE Kit

PE polo shirt with academy logo (essential)
PE shorts with academy logo (optional) Alternatively, plain navy tracksuit bottoms may be worn
SWB leggings with academy logo (optional) Alternatively, plain navy/black leggings may be worn
PE socks (navy/amber)
Sports trainers
Shin pads (Football & Hockey)
A piece/item of swimming costume

Optional Items

Plain dark belt – (optional)
Navy or black warm beanie hat and gloves for PE lessons during winter – (optional)
Plain navy long sleeve V neck woollen jumper – (optional)
Summer polo T-Shirt with logo – (optional)
Football boots and boot bag – (optional)
Outdoor PE fleece top with academy logo – (optional)
Navy base layer for PE - (optional)
Navy tracksuit bottoms with Academy logo – (optional)
Reversible/showerproof jacket – (optional)

Jewellery (All jewellery must be removed for PE)

A watch
Once small stud earring in each ear, these should not be below the ear lobe due to health and safety

General Information

Pupils MUST remove coats/hats on entering the academy
Mobile phones MUST be placed in a phone pouch that will be provided. If lost or broken parents/carers will be expected to purchase a new one
Where headscarves are worn for religious reasons only, these should be plain navy or black
Facial piercings are not allowed
Excessive makeup is not permitted including
No extreme hairstyles/tramlines and hair colouring MUST be natural
Nails should be below the fingertip and natural, no BIAB, gel or acrylic
Pupils arriving at the academy without correct uniform may be sent home to change to return as soon as items are rectified

Essential Equipment

You should arrive to the Academy each day with the following equipment:

- Black/blue pen
- Pencil
- Green pen
- Ruler
- Knowledge organiser (provided by the Academy on day 1)
- Phone pouch
- White board pens (optional)

You may wish to bring in spare pens and pencils as well as highlighters and we encourage you to do this. If an item is missing on arrival, you will have the opportunity to collect the item free of charge from Attwood Dining area. Items will be available from 8:25-8:35. If you are late to the Academy the same offer is available however, the item needs to be collected from Brindley floor and students will be sanctioned for not meeting a CORE value of Organisation.

When you arrive to Personal Tutor time you will be expected to display your equipment on an equipment mat - as soon as you enter so your Personal Tutor can visually check that you have the items needed for the day. If you arrive to Personal Tutor time without the essential equipment outlined, you will still receive the item for the day however, this will be issued with an S2.

At Ormiston SWB, we expect you to be organised. In each lesson, your classroom teacher will insist that your desks are organised with the essential equipment and will check this whilst completing the register.
